COURSE NAME: JAPANESE FOR PRE-INTERMEDIATE 1

WHO SHOULD TAKE THIS COURSE?

Learners have finished at least 20 hours of training for beginners. They have the ability to understand simple sentences and want to improve in vocabulary, sentence structure and fluency.

PROGRAM

Week 1	Using basic greetings when visiting people - Talking about giving and receiving gifts Talking about characteristics of things and people
Week 2	Praising someone's possessions Talking about giving and receiving gifts - Expressing gratitude
Week 3	Making a telephone call Talking about events -Making plans - Invite someone to an event
Week 4	Talking about what you own - Offering to help / accept someone's offer Giving a reason for offering someone something, inviting someone to do something
Week 5	Talking about weekend plans and travel plans: state what you will do in what order Talking about schedules
Week 6	Asking someone to do something for you Ask to have something delivered by a specific means from a store or office
Week 7	Give directions to taxi driver Talking about getting on and off means of transports and departure times Talking about length of stays - Ask about travel times
Week 8	Asking permission to do something at someone house or at a store Granting or refusing permission, and giving reason for doing so
Week 9	Forbidding someone from doing something and giving a reason for doing so Asking someone not to do something
Week 10	Talking about where you live, where you work and who your acquaintances are Asking where something you are looking for is sold

WHAT'S SPECIAL ABOUT THE COURSE?

The fee includes:

- Teaching materials (book and CDs or tapes).
- Free access and use of Vietnamese teaching materials, CDs and newspapers at the school's mini-library during school opening hours.
- Free access to language exchange groups /meet-up (if there is one available at the time you enrol)

EXPECTED OUTCOME

By the end of this course students will be able to:

- pronounce all the sounds and tones in Japanese
- recognise the tones when listening to a Japanese word.
- say hello, goodbye, thank you and greetings
- tell and listen to the time
- say numbers, weeks, months and years
- order food at a restaurant
- ask a receptionist at a hotel
- asking for direction
- get a taxi or buying a train ticket
- bargain in Japanese currency

TUITION

Course Duration: 10 weeks, 2 hour session per week

Course Fee: \$ 320 for standard 10-week class

PLEASE NOTE:

- The enrolment fee must be paid **at least** one week in advance of the course commencement date.

- All classes need a minimum of 5 students to go ahead. If your course does not have enough 5 students, it will be cancelled and you will be informed via SMS or E-mail. Alternatively, we may still offer the course for 4 students with a little bit higher tuition fee with your agreement.
- You'll need to dedicate approximately 2 to 3 hours per week outside of class time to your course, mostly to listen to the CD. You can do this at our school after or before class or any time at your convenience.
- If you would like to gain a better idea of our approach to teaching, you are more than welcome to sit in one of our current class of the same level.
